L2B – Names for tickets

London to Brighton this year is held on the 18th May. EDMC have managed to bag a club stand again – this year the theme is 'Heroes', so get your thinking caps on! However – this year there are only 12 club stand places, so we will require ticket money **no later than February meeting** (cut off date 29th Feb)

This year all tickets are **£25 per car** (whether run or stand) plus 36p p&p. This includes all the usual t-shirt etc. There will be the usual Soap Box Challenge & Show 'n Shines, but no mention of a Pit Stop Challenge, so we can't defend our title!

We require 6 cars for stand & up to 20 cars for run. At time of printing, we need 2 more cars for the stand. If we don't reach 6 cars, then EDMC will only apply for run tickets as we wont be allowed a stand with less than 6.

These spaces are first come first served. If we reach our limit then others will have to apply through MiniWorld Magazine in March & April issues.
